Ephesians 2:1-10 – Sola Gratia – Saved By Grace Alone

“Search Scripture through, and you must, if you read it with a candid mind, be persuaded that the doctrine of salvation by grace alone is the greatest doctrine in the word of God.”

Big Idea of this Series: There are foundational truths from God's Word that we must believe in order to be saved and transformed into the image of Christ.

Big Idea of Today's Message: Christians are saved by the grace of God alone.

Review/Overview of the Five Solas – The radical message of a God who does all the saving and who leaves nothing for man to claim as his own contribution to gain God's favor.

“What is the foundation upon which my salvation rests?” According to the Scriptures ALONE...

“What must I earn to be saved?” ...salvation is by grace ALONE...

“What must I do to be saved?” ...through faith ALONE...

“What or who must I trust to be saved?” ...in Christ ALONE...

“What is the point?” ...for God's glory ALONE!

Definition of grace

Ephesians 2:1-10 is one passage of Scripture in which the doctrine of salvation by grace alone shines brightly.

Vv. 1-3 – What we were before God saved us.

Vv. 4-7 – What we are because of what He has done.

Vv. 8-10 – How He did it.
