Big Idea of this Series: The five “Solas” summarize the radical gospel message from God’s Word that God does all the saving and leaves nothing for man to claim as his own contribution to gain God’s favor and acceptance.

Big Idea of Today’s Message: Jesus Christ is the only mediator between God and man and there is salvation through no other.

Christ alone is at the center of the “Solas” and biblical theology.

Christ alone is the only way to God and the only hope for salvation.

Christ alone is the affirmation that He did everything necessary for sinners to be saved.
