“I Believe in the Holy Spirit.” The Apostles’ Creed

John 14:15-18, 26; 15:26-27; 16:13

Big Idea of this Series: The Apostles’ Creed is a concise summary of the main points of the Christian faith and will help us avoid and correct error and be strengthened and matured in our faith.

Big Idea of Today’s Message: God the Holy Spirit, the third person of our Triune God, has come to live in us and to work in us to bring to bear all the benefits of Jesus’ work for us.

Who is the Holy Spirit and what does He do?

God the Holy Spirit is with us and lives in us.

God the Holy Spirit is the Spirit of truth and will teach us and guide us into all truth.

God the Holy Spirit will testify of the Lord Jesus Christ.

God the Holy Spirit will give God’s peace to us.

“I believe in God, the Father Almighty, the Maker of heaven and earth,
and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord: Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried;
He descended to the dead. The third day He arose again from the dead;
He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty;
from there He shall come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit; the holy Christian church; the communion of saints;
the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen.”

The Apostles’ Creed

“It can be well argued that once the personality of the Spirit is established, the argument about His deity is over. The ‘Spirit of God’ who is said to be omnipresent (Psalm 139:7), omniscient (1 Corinthians 2:10-11), and active in the very creation itself (Genesis 1:2; Psalm 104:30) hardly fits the description of some kind of lesser being. But the fact that this Spirit shares the one divine name with the Father and the Son (Matthew 28:19) makes His deity indisputable.” ~James White

“The Spirit’s message to us is never, ‘Look at Me; listen to Me; come to Me; get to know Me,’ but always, ‘Look at Him (Christ), and see His glory; listen to Him, and hear His word; go to Him, and have life; get to know Him, and taste His gift of joy and peace.’” ~J. I. Packer

“You might as well expect to raise the dead by whispering in their ears, as hope to save souls by preaching to them, if it were not for the agency of the Spirit.” ~Charles Spurgeon

“Our churches can’t be Spirit-led unless they’re Word-fed. A church that’s dependent on the Spirit’s power in its worship will be committed to the study, proclamation, and application of God’s Word in its personal and congregational worship. The Word and the Spirit were never meant to be separated. In fact God’s Spirit is the one who inspired God’s Word... God’s Spirit and His Word go together.” ~Bob Kauflin
