Big Idea of this Series: The Apostles' Creed is a concise summary of the main points of the Christian faith and will help us avoid and correct error and be strengthened and matured in our faith.

Big Idea of Today's Message: Jesus is coming again from heaven to judge every individual who has ever lived with wrath for the unrighteous and reward for the righteous. We must live in the light of and be ready for His coming.

A chronology of events.

The biblical truth of Jesus' second coming to judge involves both wrath and reward.

The biblical truth of Jesus' second coming to judge should lead to faith and faithfulness.

"I believe in God, the Father Almighty, the Maker of heaven and earth,
and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord: Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried;
He descended to the dead. The third day He arose again from the dead;
He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty;
from there He shall come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit; the holy Christian church; the communion of saints;
the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen."
