Big Idea of this Series: The Apostles' Creed is a concise summary of the main points of the Christian faith and will help us avoid and correct error and be strengthened and matured in our faith.

Big Idea of Today's Message: The church is one, holy, universal, called-out people of God, created by God through the accomplishments of His Son and the application of His Spirit.

What is the "church" in which we believe?

The church is founded upon a radical gospel confession, vv. 16, 18a.

The church is founded upon the revealed gospel truth of God, v. 17.

The church is founded in the transforming power of the gospel, v. 18.

The church is founded with gospel authority, v. 19.

"I believe in God, the Father Almighty, the Maker of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord: Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried; He descended to the dead. The third day He arose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from there He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit; **the holy Christian church; the communion of saints;** the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen." ~The Apostles' Creed
