I Thessalonians 5:9-11

Big Truth of this Series: *Live in the Light of Jesus' Return.*

Big Truth of Today's Message: *When we begin to grasp the sinfulness of our sin and the marvel of the atoning work of Christ and eternal life, our hearts will be greatly comforted and encouraged.*

V. 9a- Our salvation is based on God's purposes.

V. 9b-10a- Our salvation is based on God's provision through the atoning death of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Why the atonement? The sinfulness of sin.

The atonement: The passive and active obedience of Christ on our behalf.

V. 10b- Our salvation based on God's promise of eternal life.

V. 11- Our salvation is the only true source of comfort and encouragement to ourselves and to others.
