The Righteous Judgments of God

2 Thessalonians 1:5-10

Big Truth of this Series: A healthy church is steadfast while waiting for Christ's return.

Big Truth of Today's Message: Christians with a "kingdom heart" trust God's loving and righteous discipline in their afflictions now and His righteous judgment of those who afflict them when Christ returns.

- ▶ Suffering and afflictions are a sure evidence of and benefit to our salvation, v. 5.
- The Second Coming of Christ is the culmination and zenith of history, vv. 7b-8a, 10a.
- ▶ God will give relief to His people when Christ returns.
- It is only just for God to give relief, vv. 6a, 7a.
- Relief will be granted only to those who know God through Christ, v. 7b.
- This will happen when the Lord Jesus returns, vv. 7c-8a, 10.
- ▶ God will give retribution to those who are not God's people when Christ returns.
 - Those who reject God and who afflict believers will receive retribution vv. 6, 8b.
 - It is only just for God to punish evildoers with the penalty of eternal destruction, away from His presence, power, and glory vv. 6, 8b-9.
 - This will happen when the Lord Jesus returns, vv. 7b-8a, 10a.
