The Righteous Judgments of God, Part 2

Big Truth of this Series: A healthy church is steadfast while waiting for Christ's return.

Big Truth of Today's Message: Believers can anticipate the return of Christ when God will pour out His righteous judgment on those who do not know God and who do not obey the gospel.

V. 6a - "Since indeed God considers it just to repay..."

V. 7b-8a, 10a – "... when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire... when He comes on that day..."

V. 6b, 7, 8b-9 – "...to repay with affliction... inflicting vengeance... they will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction away from the presence of the Lord and the glory of His might..."

V. 6b, 7b, 8b, c - "...on those who afflict you... on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus..."
