“A close study of the text nowhere suggests that the stone of the tomb was rolled away from the tomb to let Jesus out. The earthquake and rolling back of the stone are recorded in Matthew 28:2 as a sign of a wonderful event, not as the event itself. There can be only one conclusion: the body of Jesus was gone before the stone was rolled away. It did not need to be removed for Him to escape the tomb; He had already escaped it. The removal of the stone was for the disciples, not for Jesus.”

### **Colossians 2:13-15**

What has God done for us and in us through the death and resurrection of Christ?

#### **1. Sins Forgiven**

*V. 13* – God “has forgiven us all our trespasses...”

#### **2. Debt Cancelled**

*V. 14* – God “has cancelled the record of debt that stood against us...”

#### **3. Enemies Defeated**

*V. 15* – God has “disarmed the rulers and authorities...”
