Encouragement From the Second Coming of Jesus Christ

2 Thessalonians 2:1-5

Big Truth of this Series: A healthy church is steadfast while waiting for Christ's return.

Big Truth of Today's Message: Jesus Christ is coming again to judge the living and the dead, but He will not return before the great apostasy and the revelation of the antichrist.

 $V.\ I$ — "Now concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our being gathered together to Him, we ask you, brothers..."

V. 2 — "...not to be quickly shaken in mind or alarmed, either by a spirit or a spoken word, or a letter seeming to be from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord has come."

V. 3 — "Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction..."

V. 4 — "... who opposes and exalts himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God."

V. 5 – "Do you not remember that when I was still with you I told you these things?"
