## Stand Firm and Hold Fast to Truth 2 Thessalonians 2:13-17

**Big Truth of this Series:** A healthy church is steadfast while waiting for Christ's return.

**Big Truth of Today's Message:** By standing firmly on and holding tightly to God's truth, we will be encouraged in our hearts and be established in our deeds and words.

"But we ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers beloved by the Lord, because God chose you from the beginning to be saved, through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth. To this He called you through our gospel, so that you may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ." (v. 13-14)

- So then, brothers, stand firm (v. 15)
- and hold to (v. 15)
- the traditions that you were taught by us, either by our spoken word or by our letter. (v. 15)
- Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and God our Father, who loved us and gave us eternal comfort and good hope through grace (v. 16)
- comfort your hearts and establish them in every good work and word. (v. 17)
