Praying for Missions, Missionaries, and Growth in Christ 2 Thessalonians 3:1-5

Big Truth of this Series: A healthy church is steadfast while waiting for Christ's return.

Big Truth of Today's Message: We ought to pray for the proclamation of the gospel and for those who proclaim it, relying on the Lord's faithfulness to deliver, establish, guard, and guide us in every spiritual battle.

Pray for the unhindered advance of the proclamation of the gospel.

"Finally, brothers, pray for us, that the Word of the Lord (the gospel) may speed ahead and be honored, as happened among you," (v. 1)

Pray for those who proclaim the gospel to be guarded and delivered from spiritual enemies and established in the faith.

"...and that we may be delivered from wicked and evil men. For not all have faith. But the Lord is faithful. He will establish you and guard you against the evil one." (vv. 2-3)

Pray for confidence in the Lord for growth in obedience to all His commands and for God-centered love and Christ-like endurance.

"And we have confidence in the Lord about you, that you are doing and will do the things that we command. May the Lord direct your hearts to the love of God and to the steadfastness of Christ." (w. 4-5)
