What Will You Do When the End Comes? 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12

Big Truth of this Series: A healthy church is steadfast while waiting for Christ's return.

Big Truth of Today's Message: The revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ from Heaven will be preceded by the great rebellion/apostasy and by the revelation of the man of lawlessness, who is described in detail.

 $Vv. \ I-3a$ — Don't be deceived or alarmed: Christ's Second Coming will not happen before two obvious events take place.

V. 3b – The Second Coming will not happen before the great rebellion/falling away.

V. 3b – The Second Coming will not happen before the man of lawlessness is revealed. Although Paul had told them in detail about these two events (v. 5), he clearly describes the man of lawlessness.

v. 3b – His perverse character.

v. 4 – His God-defying activity.

vv. 6-8a – His present concealment and future revelation.

v. 8b - His decisive defeat.

vv. 9-10a - His relation to Satan and to Satan's power to deceive.

vv. 10b-12 — His sin-hardened and hell-bound followers.
