Ezra 1:4-2:70

Big Truth of this Series: God is working to glorify Himself in His people through restoration, revival, and repentance.

Big Truth of Today's Message: God stirs the hearts of His covenant people to commit to Him in worship, community, service, and giving; and God provides what we need for these tasks.

God's call to go and rebuild the temple Committed to worship. (1:3, 5)

God's remnant's journey to Judah

Committed to community and service. (1:5; 2:1-70)

God's provision for the task

Committed to giving generously to God's work. (1:4, 6-7; 2:68-69)
