Big Truth of this Series: God is working to glorify Himself in His people through restoration, revival, and repentance.

Big Truth of Today's Message: You must prepare yourself and your loved ones to overcome opposition and complete the task the Lord Jesus Christ has given you.

Maintain a continual posture of repentance and deal quickly with personal sin (Ezra 5:1-3; Haggai 1:1, 7-8; Zechariah 1:1, 3-6).

Reprioritize... daily. Get rid of things that drag you into sin (Ezra 5:2, 5; Haggai 1:5-6).

Study, do, and teach God's Word (Ezra 7:10; Haggai 1:1; Zechariah 1:1).

Meet together with and work alongside God's people for worship, ministry, and encouragement (Ezra 5:1; 6:16).

Let oppression press you into God and His work, and be obedient and faithful unto death (Haggai 1:13-14).
