*Behold Our God*

**Holy** - “In the Scriptures, there is one primary meaning and one secondary meaning of the term holy. The secondary meaning is that which refers to personal righteousness and purity. However, the primary meaning of the word is “separate,” or, if you will, theological apartheid. That which is holy is that which is other—that which is different from something else.

“When the Bible speaks about God’s holiness, the primary thrust of those statements is to refer to God’s transcendence, to His magnificence, to that sense in which God is higher and superior to anything there is in the creaturely realm. Again, the simplest way to discuss this is to say that which is holy is that which is different.” ~R. C. Sproul

**Fear of the Lord** – “The continual awareness that I am in the presence of a holy, just, and almighty God, and that every thought, word, action, and deed is open before him and is being judged by him.”

# Truth In Balance

Isaiah 6:1-8

**Introduction**

- When only one side of a balanced TRUTH is vastly over emphasized, it becomes \_\_\_\_\_.
- Christianity is primarily internal. When we align our internal desires with Christ’s Lordship, then our faith becomes external.

**Isaiah’s heart’s need**

- During anxious and uncertain times. . . we should turn our attention to the \_\_\_\_\_ who sits on the throne and in control.

**Isaiah’s vision**

- God is holy and His glory limitless.
- Isaiah used the word \_\_\_\_\_, a title “Sovereign One” involves relationship—God’s total possession and my total submission—**“MY God,” “MY Lord and MY Master.”**
- The Seraphim used the word \_\_\_\_\_, the sacred (unspeakable to the Jews) name of God – “I AM.”

**Isaiah’s reaction**

- “Woe is me!” Who was Isaiah talking to? \_\_\_\_\_.
- What was Isaiah’s emotional state? He was \_\_\_\_\_.

**The heavenly response**

- God through the Seraphim/coal established the atonement for Isaiah’s sins.
- What did Isaiah do? \_\_\_\_\_, he just received God’s atoning work.

**Isaiah’s commission**

- In Isaiah’s state of God initiated righteousness, he was able to listen and speak to the Lord.
- He appreciates his right standing with God and was moved to \_\_\_\_\_.
