Lord, from Sorrows Deep I Call Question: "What do you understand by the providence of God?" Answer: "The almighty, everywhere present power of God, whereby, as it were, by His hand, He still upholds heaven and earth with all creatures and so governs them that herbs and grass, rain and drought, fruitful and barren years, meat and drink, health and sickness, riches and poverty, indeed, all things come not by chance, but by His Fatherly hand." - Heidelberg Catechism, Question 27

"Worry is the sin of distrusting the promise and providence of God, and yet it is a sin that Christians commit perhaps more frequently than any other." - John MacArthur

"Let me encourage you to take those 'if onlys' and draw a circle around them. Then label the circle, 'The providence of God.' The Christian believes that God is greater than our 'if onlys.' His providential hand encompasses the whole of our lives, not just the good days but the 'bad' days, too. We have the word 'accident' in our vocabulary; God does not." - Erwin Lutzer

- God is at work through weak and disadvantaged people (2:5-7).
