Eleven people from Heritage Baptist Church traveled to Haiti May 27– June 3 to minister among the Haitian people through our partnership with Mission of Hope Haiti. It was a very profitable trip filled with ministry projects which included a Mobile Medical Clinic (Crystal and Laura), providing families with goats to help with family income, Kids Clubs with two different groups of children and SVT, or Strategic Village Time. We also worshipped with a Haitian church and ate a lot of wonderful food. We spent the majority of our time doing SVT, meeting Haitians in their village, sharing about water safety and then sharing with them about Jesus, the Water of Life. Every team member was actively involved in initiating conversations and sharing the



gospel. Many lives were touched and a good number became followers of Jesus through the witness of the team. It was a wonderful experience and we are looking forward to returning again next year.
