Big Truth of this Series: God is working to glorify Himself by sending a deliverer to rebuild our broken walls and call us to worship and obedience in the face of opposition.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: To serve God realistically and effectively, you must learn to wait on Him, to work with other Christians, and to wrestle wisely with problems.

To serve God realistically and effectively, you must:

- Learn to wait on Him (2:1a).
- Learn to work with others (2:1b-8).
- Have vision and wrestle wisely with problems (2:9-20).
