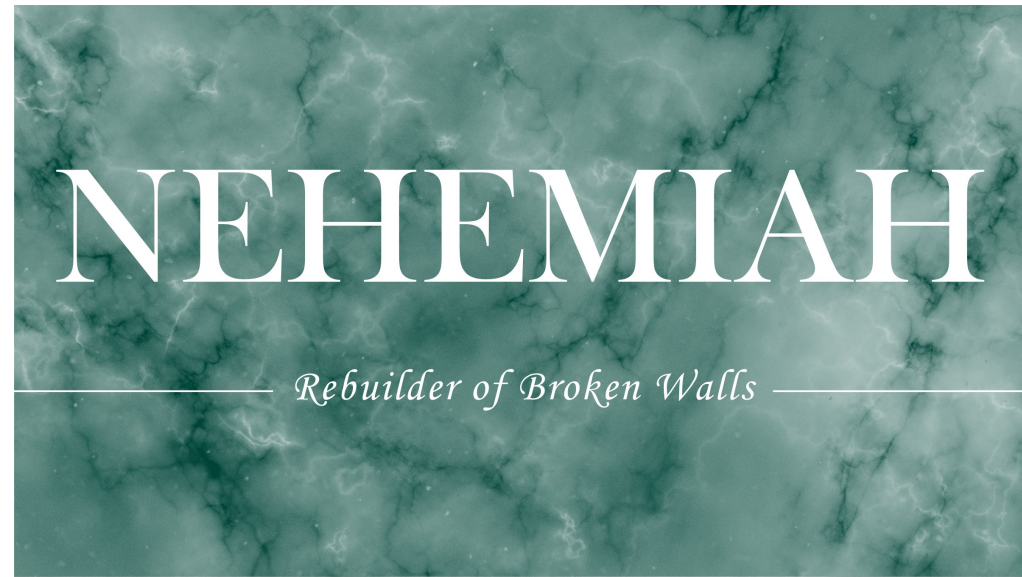

Citizen Soldiers, Part I

Nehemiah 4:1-23

Big Truth of this Series: God is working to glorify Himself by sending a deliverer to rebuild our broken walls and call us to worship and obedience in the face of opposition.

Big Truth of Today's Message: As you build for the Lord and His glory you will face opposition from without. You must expect it, turn to the Lord, and prepare for battle.

Expect opposition. Don't be surprised by it, but don't ignore it (4:1-3).

When your attacks come from all around, first take the fight vertical (4:4-5).

Be alert and ready for battle and keep on building (4:6, 9).
