

More Counterattacks from Without Nehemiah 6:1-19

Big Truth of this Series: God is working to glorify Himself by sending a deliverer to rebuild our broken walls and call us to worship and obedience in the face of opposition.

Big Truth of Today's Message: As you build Christ's Kingdom for His glory and the good of the church, you will face vicious attacks meant to frighten you into quitting. You are doing a great work and cannot stop, run away, or take the easy way out.

Review:

In order to persevere in the "great work" God has called you to accomplish:

- You must fight off distraction, stay on task, and maintain your priorities. (6:1-4)
- You must reject misinformation, be truthful, and strengthen your hands. (6:5-9)
- You must resist the temptation to compromise and run from danger.
 6:10-13)
- You must complete your commission and understand the battle never stops. (5:14-19)
