Prayer Meeting July 3, **5:00pm** in the Chapel. Join us for an hour of prayer, seeking the Lord's will through His revealed truth.



Building Our Lives on God's Word, Part 3 Nehemiah 8:1-18

Big Truth of this Series: God is working to glorify Himself by sending a deliverer to rebuild our broken walls and call us to worship and obedience in the face of opposition.

Big Truth of Today's Message: We look back in remembrance and forward in anticipation of God's provision for a new home, and we celebrate with "very great rejoicing."

Israel's festivals commemorated what God had done for them in the past while looking to a fuller revelation in the promised Messiah.

Consistent intake of God's Word is vital, with men taking the lead in their families. (8:13-15)

Intake of God's Word must be accompanied by pursuit of insight into God's Word. (8:13-15)

Intake and insight into God's Word should lead to joyful obedience to God's Word. (8:16-18)
