

### Malachi: Dealing with Spiritual Defection - Part 2

**Big Truth of this Series:** God sent His messenger to deliver His message to Judah to stop their spiritual defection from Him and to return to Him with all their hearts.

**Big Truth of Today's Message:** God's people can grow lukewarm, insensitive, and indifferent to the incredible blessings God has bestowed upon them. He calls them to return to Him with the promise that He will return to them.

Introduction: Signs of Defecting from God

Am I indifferent to God's plan for marriage? (2:10-16)

Am I indifferent to the stewardship of God's provisions to me? (3:6-12)

Am I indifferent to my words? (3:13-15)

The remedy for spiritual indifference:
