

**Preeminence of Jesus Christ as  
the Only Mediator, Part 2**  
I Timothy 2:5-7

**Big Truth of this Series:** God has commissioned the people of God, the church, to be grounded in sound doctrine and to live in a godly manner according to His truth.

**Big Truth of Today’s Message:** A healthy church teaches and proclaims unapologetically that Jesus Christ is the only Mediator between God and men through the ransom price of His own life. This is beautifully pictured in the ordinances of Baptism and the Lord’s supper.

5 For there is one God,

and there is one mediator between God and men,

the man Christ Jesus,

6 who gave Himself as a ransom for all,

which is the testimony given at the proper time.

7 For this I was appointed a preacher and an apostle (I am telling the truth, I am not lying), a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.
