

Pursuing Godly Leaders in the Church

I Timothy 3:1-13

Big Truth of this Series: God has commissioned the people of God, the church, to be grounded in sound doctrine and to live in a godly manner according to His truth.

Big Truth of Today's Message: A healthy church pursues men of Christlike character to serve in the two offices of overseer/elder/pastor and deacon.

The church must appoint men who are spiritually motivated and spiritually minded. (3:1)

The church must appoint men who are attaining to the likeness of Christ. (3:2-13)

The church must appoint men who can teach and preach the Word. (3:2)
