I Timothy 3:16

Big Truth of this Series: God has commissioned the people of God, the church, to be grounded in sound doctrine and to live in a godly manner according to His truth.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: The mystery of godliness is Jesus Christ revealed in the gospel and proclaimed in this ancient confession of faith.

There was a “mystery” of godliness that was revealed in Jesus Christ. (3:16a)

Jesus was manifested in the flesh. (3:16b)

Jesus was vindicated by the Spirit. (3:16c)

Jesus was seen by angels. (3:16d)

Jesus was proclaimed among the nations. (3:16e)

Jesus was believed on in the world. (3:16f)

Jesus was taken up in glory. (3:16g)
