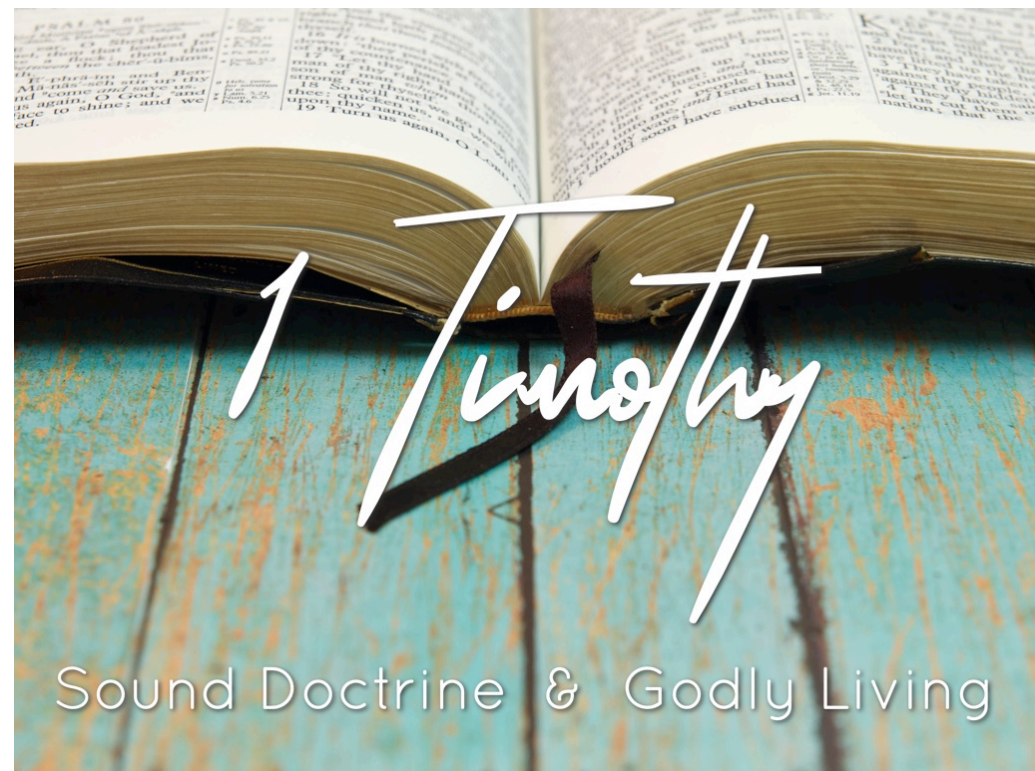

I Timothy 5:1-2

Big Truth of this Series: God has commissioned the people of God, the church, to be grounded in sound doctrine and to live in a godly manner according to His truth.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: Sound doctrine is always intensely practical, yielding godly living especially in personal relationships in the family and in the church.

The church has a ministry of correction for straying members. (5:1-2)

“Do not rebuke an older man but encourage him as you would a father, younger men as brothers, older women as mothers, younger women as sisters, in all purity.”

Elders and church members are responsible for good doctrine and godly living. (4:16)
