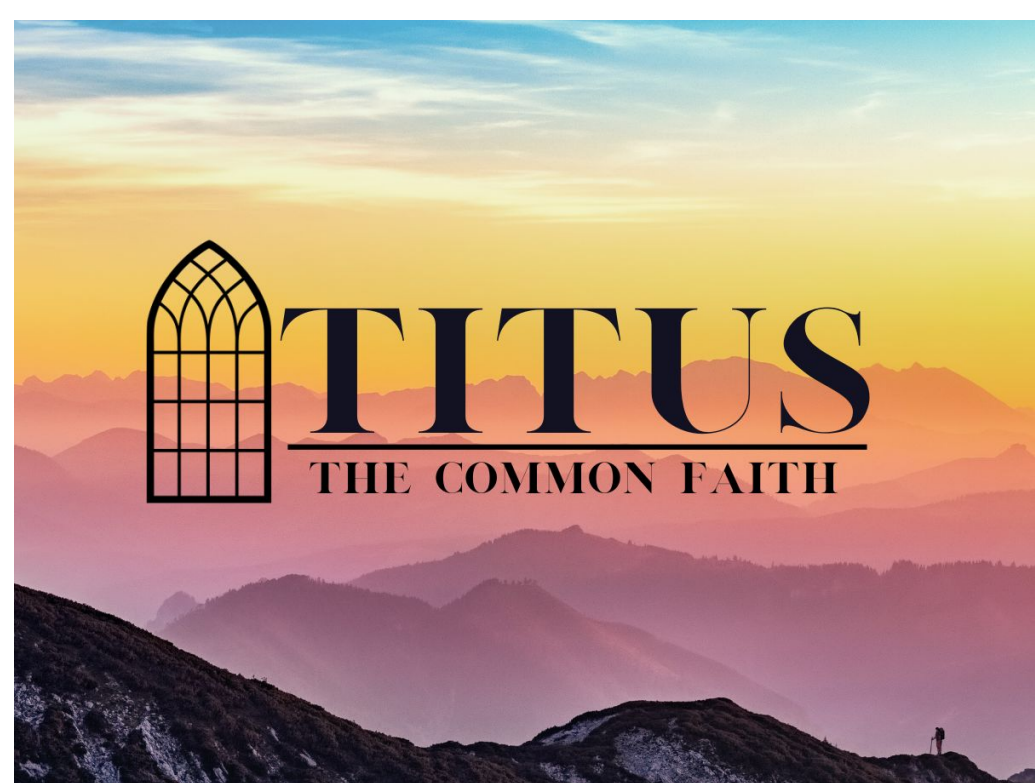

The Security, Certainty, and Continuity of Gospel Faith

Titus 1:1-4

Big Truth of this Series: With the saints through the ages, we share a common faith in gospel doctrine that inspires gospel duty and gospel duty that adorns gospel doctrine.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: Your life must be anchored in gospel truth leading to godliness, a certain hope of eternal life, and a shared foundation of faith.

God’s elect are anchored in the security of gospel truth leading to gospel godliness.

¹ Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, for the sake of the faith of God’s elect and their knowledge of the truth, which accords with godliness,

The promised hope of eternal life is anchored in the word of the God who cannot lie.

² in hope of eternal life, which God, who never lies, promised before the ages began ³ and at the proper time manifested in His word through the preaching with which I have been entrusted by the command of God our Savior;

Gospel grace and peace are anchored in our common faith in God the Father and Christ Jesus our Savior.
