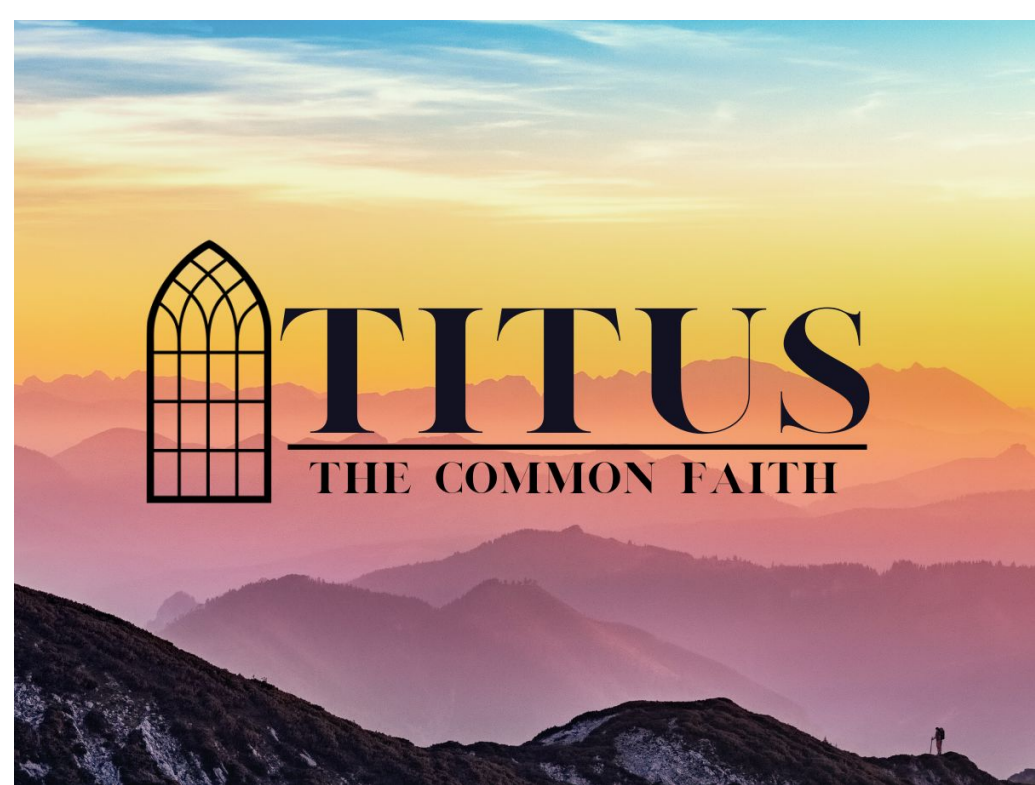
Fill Your Cup, Sat. Nov. 4, 9:30-11:00am, HBC Chapel/Café
