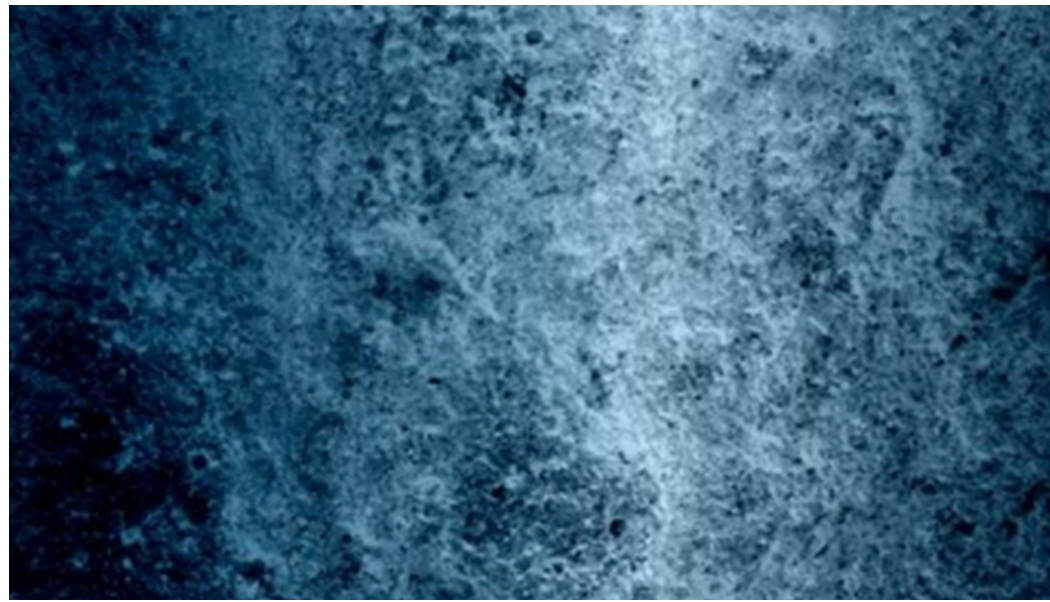

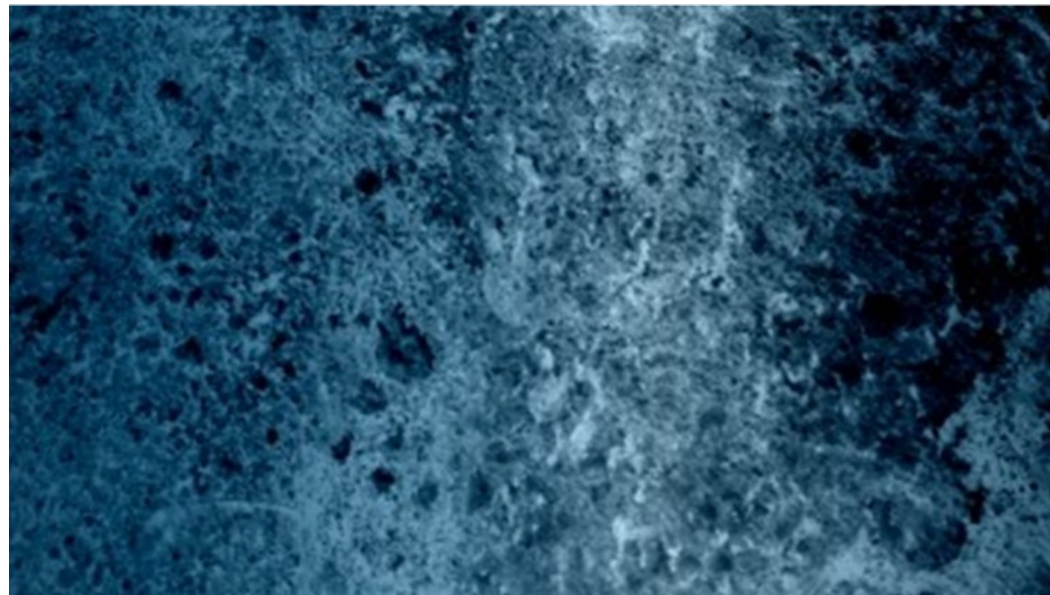
Guy's Night, Oct. 29, 5-7pm, Chapel/Café. This is just guys getting together for fun, fellowship, food, and focus on an important topic.
