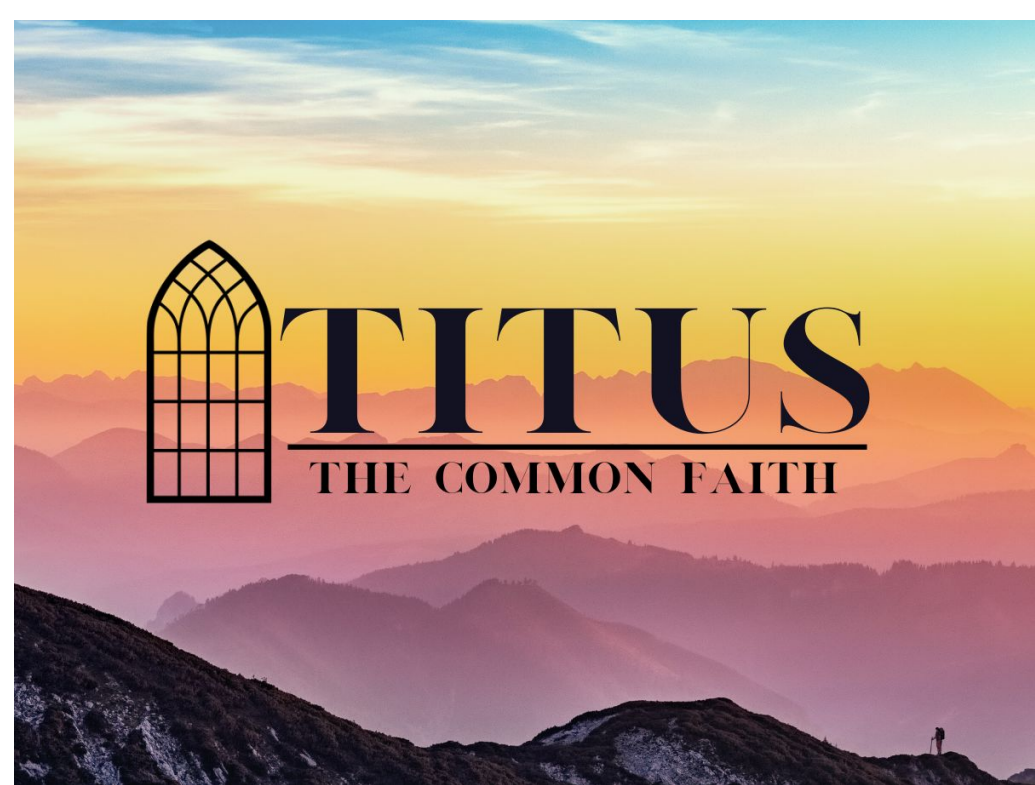

**Godward Living in God’s Family – Younger Men
Titus 2:6-8**

Big Truth of this Series: With the saints through the ages, we share a common faith in gospel doctrine that inspires gospel duty and gospel duty that adorns gospel doctrine.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: Spiritually healthy families, both the church family and the nuclear family, require younger men to have a gospelled and Godward life.

“Likewise, urge the younger men to be self-controlled...”

“Show yourself in all respects to be a model of good works...”

“And in your teaching show integrity, dignity, and sound speech that cannot be condemned...”

“So that the opponent may be put to shame, having nothing evil to say about us.”
