What did Jesus do to confirm their salvation?

Conclusion: How do you know if you are in Phase 2?

Eight characteristics of a person in phase 2

- 1. They will gain a deeper understanding of who Jesus Christ is.
- 2. They will grow in understanding of the gospel.
- 3. They will experience freedom from outward sins.
- 4. They will gain certainty about their salvation. They will know they are saved.
- 5. They will be reading the Bible several times each week and praying regularly.
- 6. They will begin to change their priorities in how they use their free time including attending a local church
- 7. They will be worshipping God regularly.
- 8. They will be baptized.

SESSION 3 After Lunch

PHASE 3 DISCIPLES IN FAITHFUL SERVICE WITH CHRIST

The occasion:

- 1. John in prison
- 2. Jesus begins His public ministry

Jesus calls His disciples to faithful service as helpers in the ministry

- 1. Follow me and I will make you fishers of men
- 2. The disciples were still working as fishermen
- 3. Roll of church leaders: Recognize spiritual gifting to edify others
- 4. He who is faithful in little is faithful in much (Luke 16:10)

Jesus takes His disciples through basic training

1. He modeled the ministry before them

- 2. He taught them basic evangelism in five areas:
 - a. Power over demons
 - b. That forgiveness of sins is through faith in Jesus Christ
 - c. Resulting in eternal life
 - d. His relationship with God the Father
 - e. How to defend their faith
- 3. He taught them how to depend upon God through prayer
- 4. They identified with Jesus publicly
- 5. He taught them about the dangers of legalism

Jesus gave them two tests:

- 1. The test of full commitment to Christ
- 2. The test of loyalty in the face of opposition

Only those who pass these tests can go on to Phase 4

Eight Characteristics of a person in phase 3

- 1. He/she is willing to be active as a helper in ministry
- 2. He/she has a good idea what is their spiritual gift.
- 3.. They know how to evangelize and does so when opportunities arise.
- 4. They know how to answer basic questions about their faith--basic apologetics.
- 5. The Bible is a living book to them. They know how to study it for themselves and to apply it to their lives
- 6. They are completely identified as a Christian in public and are active in a local church.
- 7. They have victory over their old-world system or life. They see God is victorious over more subtle sins in their lives.
- 8. They have yielded all aspects of their life to Christ's control.

SESSION 4 The last session

All believers should grow through Phases 1-3 Only those who are faithful through all three phases and pass the two tests should go into phase 4

PHASE 4 LEADERS ARE MADE

Jesus selects twelve as His future leaders

Jesus teaches His newly appointed leaders

- 1. His commissioning sermon on core values of the Kingdom
- 2. Lessons on faith and repentance
- 3. Lesson on living by faith through financial supporters
- 4. Lessons on rejection
- 5. Lessons on the kingdom of God—Kingdom parables
- 6. Lesson on Jesus being master of the sea
- 7. Lesson on overcoming demons
- 8. Lesson on compassion
- 9. Second lesson on rejection in Nazareth

Jesus sends out the twelve two by two

1. To heal the sick and cast out demons

- 2. To proclaim the kingdom of God
- 3. To live by faith financially without Jesus
- 4. Lesson on suffering--John the Baptist is beheaded
- 5. When they return, Jesus gives them a new title—apostle

Eight Characteristics of a potential leader in Phase 4

- 1. They have the foundational elements including Character, gifting, vision, etc.
- 2. They have potential to grow in their understanding and acceptance of core values.
- 3. They value the ministry of their leader. They are watching as it is being modeled.
- 4. They are secure enough to ask questions and humble enough to receive them.
- 5. They are willing and eager to get involved in the ministry.
- 6. They not only know what they believe, but why they believe it. Basic apologetics.
- 7. They are actively engaged in the ministry, sacrificially giving and involved.
- 8. They are occasionally given responsibility for ministry and they enjoy it.

PHASE 5 LEADERS ARE REMAIDE

In phase 5 Jesus challenges the apostles' presuppositions about their readiness to lead the ministry. There are still many lessons that they need to learn before they can take on the rigors of phase 6. They are outwardly ready, but they are not yet the spiritual leaders that will change the world.

Phase 5 begins with Jesus seeking to withdraw from His public ministry. However, it took some time for the transition so He could focus primarily on the Twelve apostles.


PHASE 6 LEADERS LEAD

Ten challenging days Acts 1

The leaders established the church - Pentecost Acts 2

The church spreads until Christ takes us home Acts 3 through Revelation

TIME LINE OF JESUS'S MINISTRY



Phase I Disciples Made

Phase I began with the public ministry of John the Baptist, preparing the way for the coming Messiah. Phase I transitions into Phase II with John introducing Jesus to His first disciples who put their trust in Him as the Messiah.

Phase II Disciples Confirmed

Phase II opens with the wedding at Cana of Galilee where Jesus turns water into wine. Shortly after that Jesus and his disciples went to Jerusalem for the first Passover celebration. In Phase II Jesus does specific things in order to confirm the faith of His new disciples that He is indeed the long-expected Messiah. Phase II lasted approximately four or five months.

Phase III Disciples in Helpful Service

Phase III opens with John the Baptist being taken into prison. As result, Jesus is free to begin his public ministry preaching widely to hundreds possibly thousands of people. Jesus invites his disciples to be helpers in this ministry. During this phase, Jesus teaches his disciples how to serve effectively as helpers in the ministry. Phase III lasts about seven or eight months, concluding three weeks after the second feast.

Phase IV Leaders Being Made

Phase IV opens with Jesus appointing only twelve of his many disciples to be his future leaders. It ends with the twelve being sent out two by two. When they return, Jesus gives them a new title--apostles. In Phase IV Jesus begins to train these Twelve in spiritual leadership. Phase IV lasts eight to twelve months and ends with the third Passover.

Phase V Leaders being Re-Made

Phase V opens with the third Passover and concludes 40 days after the fourth Passover. Jesus was crucified on the preparation day of the fourth Passover and ascended to the Father 40 days after His resurrection.

In this year, Jesus seeks to withdraw from his public ministry in order to focus on the deeper, inner attitudes and values of his future leaders—the twelve apostles. After his resurrection, He uses 40 days to prepare them for his departure.

Phase VI Leaders Leading

Phase VI begins with the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and the establishment of the church in Acts 2. It will end with the coming of Jesus and we meet Him in the air in the last days. We are now living in phase VI where God's chosen people worship him all around the world, being led by spiritual leaders of His universal Church. Today the gospel of Jesus Christ is spreading to the ends of the world by His disciples like you and me.
