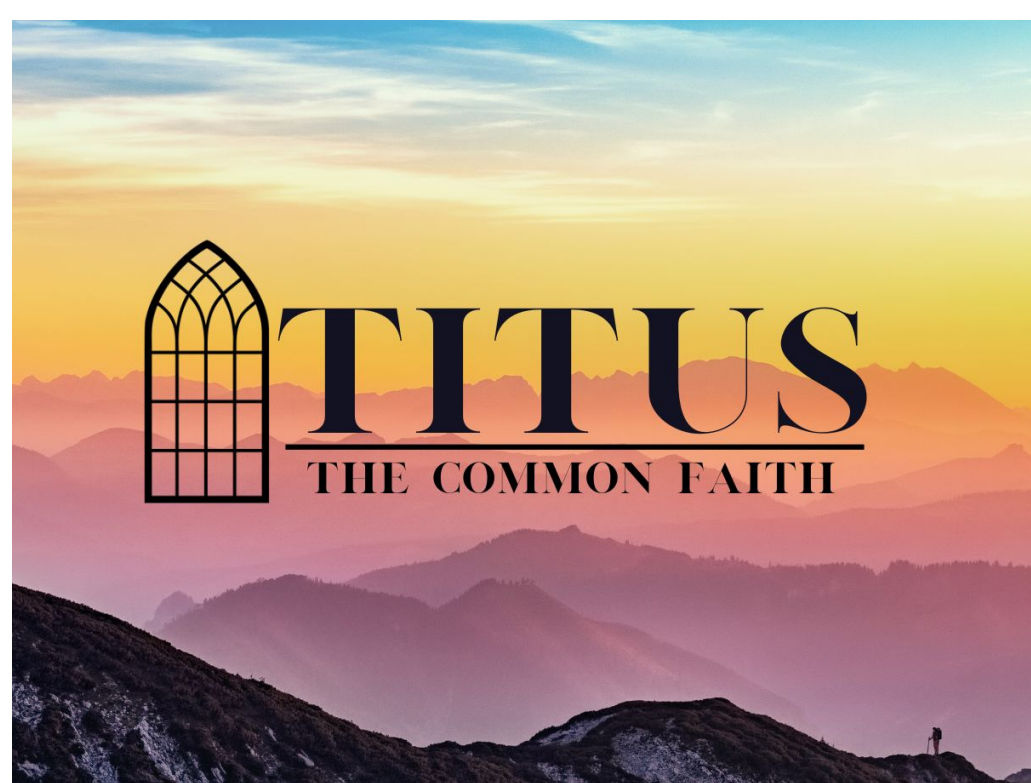

“Being saved does involve the positive response of the human will. The person who is saved begins, at a point in time, to consciously and voluntarily assent and submit to (as well as delight in) God’s revealed truth where he formerly dissented to it in open rebellion or apathetic disinterest (which is also a form of rebellion). God grants regeneration to whom He pleases, thus freeing the will, which, until the point of regeneration, is enslaved to sin and opposed to God and truth. Once the will has been set free through regeneration, faith inevitably follows. In this way it is rightly said that saving faith is a gift from God.”

What is Regeneration and Why Do We Need It? Part 3

Titus 3:5

Big Truth of this Series: With the saints through the ages, we share a common faith in gospel doctrine that inspires gospel duty that adorns gospel doctrine.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: Living godly lives flows out of being regenerated (born again). There are visible signs of being regenerate, or born again, that may be seen in every believer’s life.

“He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to His own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and the renewal of the Holy Spirit...”

Everyone who has been born again believes that Jesus is the Christ. *1 John 5:1*

No one born of God makes a practice of sinning... he does not keep on sinning. *1 John 3:9; 5:18*

Everyone who has been born of God practices righteousness and keeps himself. *1 John 2:29; 5:18b*

Everyone who has passed out of death into life (born again) loves the brothers. *1 John 3:14*

Everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. *1 John 5:4*
