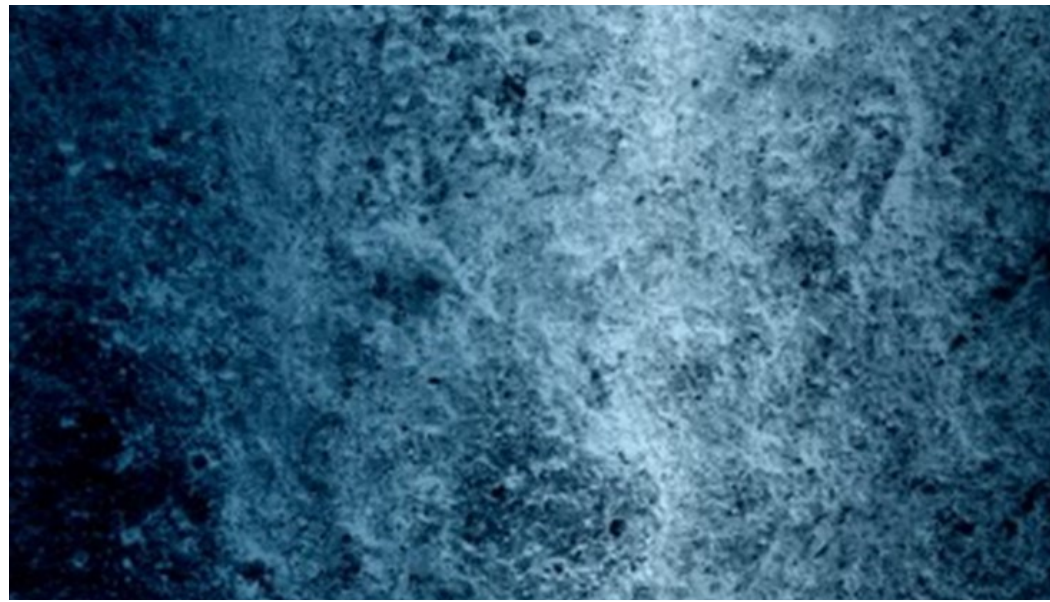

RESURRECTION CELEBRATION WEEKEND!

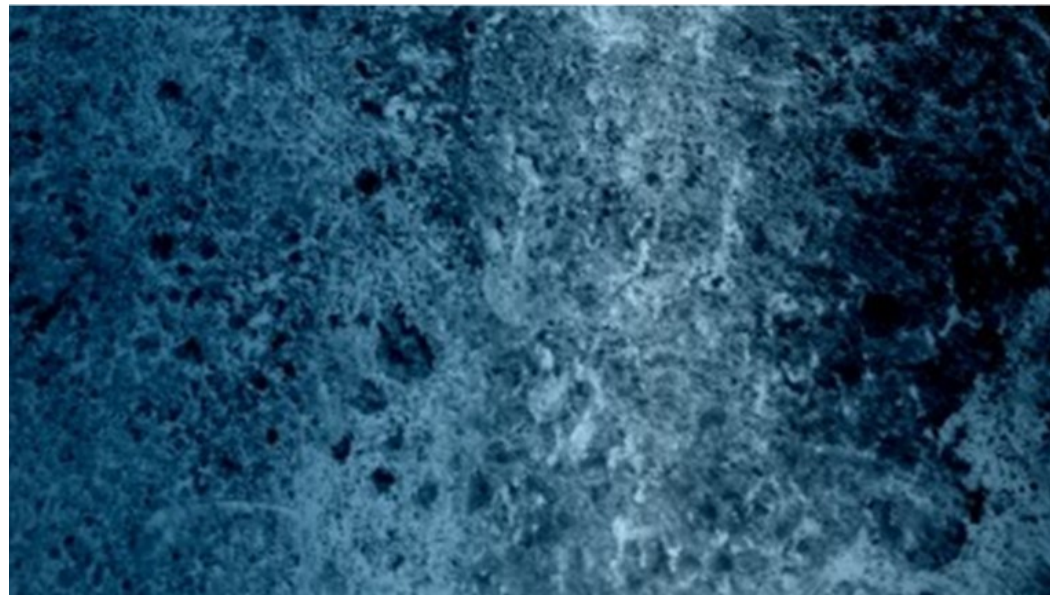
