

Avoid and Reject the Unprofitable and Profane Titus 3:9-11

Big Truth of this Series: With the saints through the ages, we share a common faith in gospel doctrine that inspires gospel duty that adorns the gospel of God our Savior.

Big Truth of Today's Message: The truly born-again Christian who loves sound doctrine must be careful to do three things: devote himself to good works, avoid unprofitable controversies, and reject profane people.

"The saying is trustworthy, and I want you to insist on these things so that those who have believed in God may be careful to devote themselves to good works. These things are excellent and profitable for people." (v. 8)

"But avoid foolish controversies, genealogies, dissensions, and quarrels about the law, for they are unprofitable and worthless." (v. 9)

"As for a person who stirs up division, after warning him once and then twice, have nothing more to do with him, knowing that such a person is warped and sinful; he is self-condemned." (v. 10-11)
