“We should not want a revival of experience alone without true reformation. And so the term revival is not adequate for our day unless we add the qualifiers ‘reformational’ or ‘Word-driven.’ It is not wrong to desire revival if we mean a revival that is a resurgence of correct believing along with the enlivening of our experience with God which comes out of (not apart from) that sound doctrine.” ~ Jim Elliff

“Only the truly faithful friend cares enough about you or me to undertake the often thankless task of pointing out where we are wrong. None of us enjoys being confronted with our faults or sins or mistakes, so we often make it difficult for our friends to do so. As a result, most of us are more concerned about speaking agreeableness to each other than about speaking the truth. This is not loyalty. Loyalty speaks the truth in faithfulness, but it also speaks the truth in love. Hold Fast the Treasure of God's Word Entrusted to You

II Timothy 1:13-18

Big Truth of this Series: The apostle Paul encourages and warns Timothy and all believers to follow, entrust, and be always ready to proclaim God's Word with confidence and joy as days of difficulty lie ahead.

Big Truth of Today's Message: We must hold fast the treasure of God's Word with faith, love, and the power of the Holy Spirit and be warned by remembering those who do not and be encouraged by remembering those who do.

vv. 13-14 – Be loyal to the treasure of God's Word and never abandon it, with a spirit of faith and love empowered by the Holy Spirit.

v.15 – An example of disloyalty to the Word. We are to avoid people like this.

vv. 16-18 – An example of loyalty to the Word. We are to emulate people like this.
