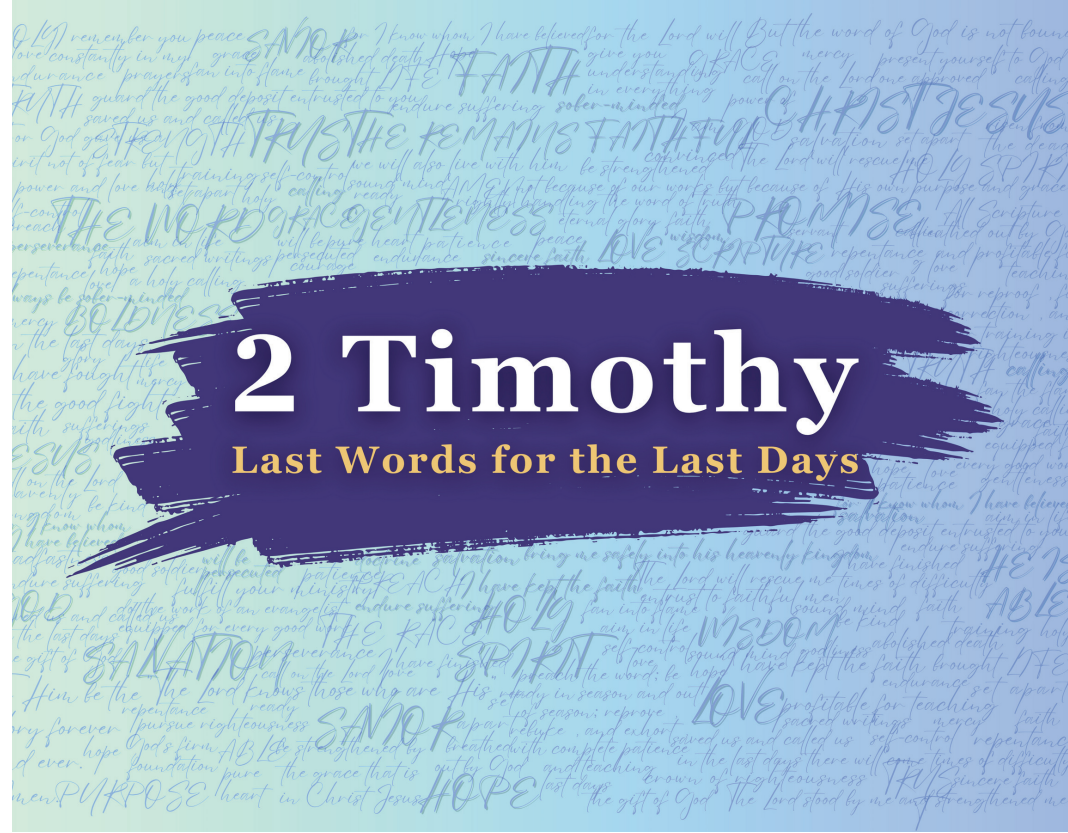

“Our real problem is not our sins. If our sins were the problem, we might muster the willpower to pull out of this nosedive. But the good news of the gospel begins with some really bad news.
