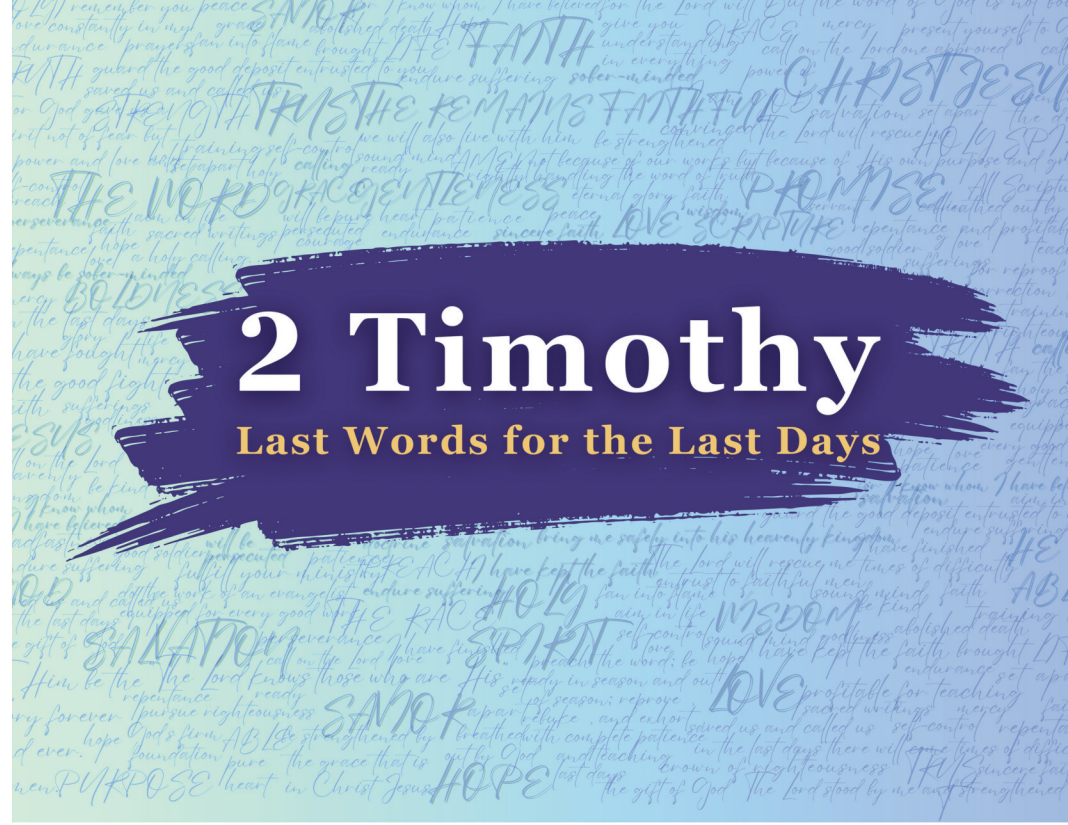

The Faithfulness of God: Hope and Warning

II Timothy 2:11-13

Big Truth of this Series: The apostle Paul encourages and warns Timothy and all believers to follow, entrust, and be always ready to proclaim God’s Word with confidence and joy as days of difficulty lie ahead.

Big Truth of Today’s Message: The faithfulness of God means that He is first of all faithful to Himself; to His own glorious character, to His promises to keep those who believe and endure, and His warnings to judge those who disbelieve and deny Him.

v. 11 “The saying is trustworthy, for: If we have died with Him, we will also live with Him...”

v. 12a “...if we endure, we will also reign with Him...”

v. 12b “...if we deny Him, He will also deny us...”

v. 13 “...if we are faithless, He remains faithful – for He cannot deny Himself.”
