
The Lord's Supper will be observed September 22 during the worship service. We do this in remembrance of the Lord, and thus proclaim His death until He comes.

## **Known by God**

## II Timothy 2:17-19

**Big Truth of this Series:** The apostle Paul encourages and warns Timothy and all believers to follow, entrust, and be always ready to proclaim God's Word with confidence and joy as days of difficulty lie ahead.

**Big Truth of Today's Message:** Amid false teaching from within and outside, God's chosen people, the church, are established on His firm foundation of Jesus' person and work, and sealed for security and purity.

v. 17-18 – The context: People in the church are impacted by false teachers.

v. 19a – But God's immovable foundation is sure and unshaken.

v. 19b – God's people, the church, bear a double seal or inscription.

v. 19c – The first part of the seal – Security: Known by God.

v. 19d – The second part of the seal – Purity: Running from sin and evil.
