

Difficult Times and People in the Church II Timothy 3:1-5

Big Truth of this Series: The apostle Paul encourages and warns Timothy and all believers to follow, entrust, and be always ready to proclaim God's Word with confidence and joy as days of difficulty lie ahead.

Big Truth of Today's Message: We must understand that the last days will bring times of difficulty in the form of difficult people, opposers of the truth, from both outside and inside the church.

 $v.\ 1-$ "But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of difficulty."

v. 2a, 4b – "For people will be lovers of self, lovers of money... lovers of pleasure... rather than lovers of God..."

v. 2b - 4a – "...proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, heartless, unappeasable, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not loving good, treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit..."

v. 5 – "...having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power. Avoid such people."
